

If the pattern has a double line around it, the seam allowances are included.

**Note:** By default, seam allowances are NOT included (single line) and will need to be added when laying out and cutting details.

Seam Allowance: 1 cm on all seams; hem guidelines are printed on pattern.

**Important!** Please print all the paper patterns and lay them out at the width of fabric you plan to use (usually from 90 to 150 cm) to see how much fabric you will need.

Don't forget to take into account pieces to be duplicated or cut on a fold. When sewing the garment, pay attention to notches. They must match up with corresponding pieces.

## 5014 Jacket with shaping seams

Recommendations on fabric: wool/semi-wool of natural or mixed fibers.

You will also need: fusible interfacing; 3 buttons; lining.

### CUTTING:

The word, "beam" used on some patterns means "straight of grain". Some pieces will be cut on the fold, this is noted on the pattern piece. Mark all notches and other design features such as darts, pleats etc. from the pattern onto your fabric.

Seam allowances: all seams 1 cm.

### Main fabric:

1. Outer collar – cut 1
2. Inner collar – cut 1
3. Center back – cut 1
4. Side back– cut 2
5. Front – cut 2
6. Side front – cut 2
7. Upper sleeve – cut 2
8. Lower sleeve – cut 2



9. Front facing band– cut 2
10. Back neck facing – cut 1

Lining:

1. Center back – cut 1
2. Side back – cut 2
3. Side front – cut 2
4. Center front – cut 2
5. Pocket sacking – cut 4
6. Upper sleeve – cut 2
7. Lower sleeve – cut 2

Interfacing:

1. Front facing band
2. Back neck facing
3. Side front
4. Center front
5. Upper center back with armhole section
6. Center back hem
7. Armholes of side back
8. Side back hem
9. Lower sleeve hem
10. Upper sleeve hem
11. Collar

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Apply interfacing to the wrong side of the following pieces: front band facing, back neck facing, side front piece, center front piece, upper center back piece (including the armhole section), center back hem, side back armhole area, side back hem, lower sleeve hem, upper sleeve hem, and collar.
2. Place the pocket bag on the side and center front pieces, right sides together, matching notches, and stitch. Press the seam toward the pocket bag and topstitch on the pocket bag.
3. Sew the side front piece to the center front piece and pocket bag. Clip into curves and press the seam open, pressing the pocket into place.
4. Sew the front facing bands with rounded corners along the upper and lower edges of the center front pieces. Trim the seam allowance and turn the corners right side out.
5. Sew the back neck facing to the front facing bands. Press the shoulder seams of the facing and front bands open.

6. Sew the side back pieces to the center back piece. Clip into curves and press the seam open.
7. Sew the garment shoulder and side seams. Press the seam allowances open.
8. Pin the outer collar to the inner collar, right sides together, and stitch around the outer edge (with rounded corners). Trim the collar corners and turn the collar right side out.
9. Sew the center back seam of the outer collar and attach it to the neckline. Press the seam allowances open.
10. Sew the vertical dart, continuing into the collar seam.
11. Attach the inner collar. Press the vertical darts and the collar joining seam open.
12. Secure the collar joining seams.
13. Sew the sleeve elbow seam and press it open.
14. Sew the sleeve front seam and press it open.
15. Sew a gathering stitch along the sleeve cap for ease. Set the sleeves into the armholes, matching notches and adjusting ease.
16. Sew the lining pieces, leaving an opening in the right sleeve seam for turning. Press the lining.
17. Sew in the shoulder pads.
18. Sew the lining to the front facing bands and back neck facing, to the garment hem, and to the sleeve hems, matching lining seams to garment seams. Make 7 tacks above the seams along the garment hem.
19. Turn the garment right side out through the sleeve opening. Sew the opening closed.
20. Make buttonholes on the right front and sew the buttons onto the left front.
