

If the pattern has a double line around it, the seam allowances are included.

Note: By default, seam allowances are NOT included (single line) and will need to be added when laying out and cutting details.

Seam Allowance: 1 cm on all seams; hem guidelines are printed on pattern.

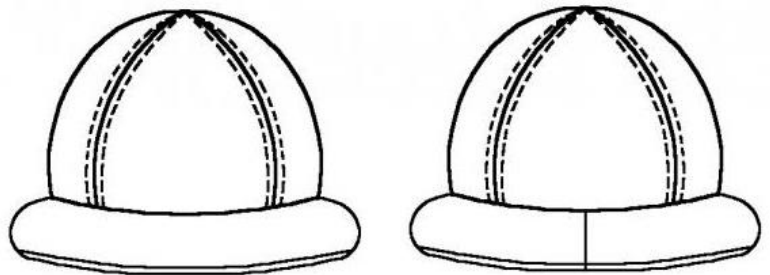
Important! Please print all the paper patterns and lay them out at the width of fabric you plan to use (usually from 90 to 150 cm) to see how much fabric you will need.

Don't forget to take into account pieces to be duplicated or cut on a fold. When sewing the garment, pay attention to notches. They must match up with corresponding pieces.

5580 Faux leather hat with fur brim

Recommendations on fabric: faux leather, faux fur with long pile.
Other materials: lining, fusible interfacing.

CUTTING:



The word, "beam" used on some patterns means "straight of grain". Some pieces will be cut on the fold, this is noted on the pattern piece. Mark all notches and other design features such as darts, pleats etc. from the pattern onto your fabric.

Faux leather:

1. Crown gore - 4 pieces
2. Bottom detail of brim - 1 piece

Faux fur:

1. Top detail of brim - 1 piece

Lining fabric:

1. Crown gore - 4 pieces

Lining:

1. Crown gore - 4 pieces
2. Bottom detail of brim - 1 pieces

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Apply fusible interfacing to the crown gore details and the bottom of the brim.
2. Stitch the crown gores in pairs, fold them right side inward. Topstitch the seams by 0.2 cm. Fold the double-stitched gores with the right side inward so that the midpoints coincide and stitch. Top off the seams.
3. Fold the details of the brim made of leather and fur with the sides inward, fasten in several places, grind along the outer edge and ends. Trim seams at the corners. Turn the brim to the right side, straightening the seam well. Fold over the brim in two layers and trim the inner edge, specifying the size of the brim. Fasten the ends of the brim into a ring with blind stitches.
4. Place the head in the brim and stitch. Bend the brim up.
5. Sew the lining details in the same way as for the top. Insert the lining into the head, fasten the seams of the lining and top. Fold back the edge of lining and sew with blind stitches.

Congratulations, your hat is ready :)

2. Stitch the crown gores in pairs, right sides together. Topstitch the seams by 0.2 cm. Fold the double-stitched gores with the right sides together so that the midpoints coincide and stitch. Top stitch the seams.
3. Pin and stitch center back edges of each brim panel. Pin the details of the brim made of leather and fur with the right sides together, stitch along the outer edge. Turn the brim to the right side, straightening the seam well. Fold over the brim in two layers and trim the inner edge, specifying the size of the brim.
4. Place the crown in the brim and stitch. Bend the brim up.
5. Sew the lining details in the same way as for the top. Insert the lining into the crown, fasten the seams of the lining and top. Fold the edge of lining and sew with blind stitches.
