

If the pattern has a double line around it, the seam allowances are included.

**Note:** By default, seam allowances are NOT included (single line) and will need to be added when laying out and cutting details.

Seam Allowance: 1 cm on all seams; hem guidelines are printed on pattern.

**Important!** Please print all the paper patterns and lay them out at the width of fabric you plan to use (usually from 90 to 150 cm) to see how much fabric you will need.

Don't forget to take into account pieces to be duplicated or cut on a fold. When sewing the garment, pay attention to notches. They must match up with corresponding pieces.

## 5717 Lightweight wool hoodie with belt

Recommendations on fabric: soft wool (easy to drape).

You will also need: piping.

### CUTTING:

The word, "beam" used on some patterns means "straight of grain". Some pieces will be cut on the fold, this is noted on the pattern piece. Mark all notches and other design features such as darts, pleats etc. from the pattern onto your fabric.

Seam allowances: all seams 1 cm.

### Main fabric:

1. Back part – 1 piece
2. Front part – 2 pieces
3. Sleeve – 2 pieces
4. Hood – 2 pieces
5. Waistband – 1 piece
6. Belt loop – 1 piece

### INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Stitch the center seam of the hood. Press the seam. Press the piping in half



- lengthwise. Trim the seam allowances with the piping.
2. Stitch the shoulder seams. Neaten the seams and press them toward the back.
  3. Stitch the hood to the neckline. Press the seam toward the hood. Trim the seam allowance with the piping.
  4. Trim the sleeve hems with the piping.
  5. Set the sleeves into the open armholes.
  6. Stitch the sleeve and side seams in one continuous seam. Press the seam allowances open.
  7. Trim the garment hem with the piping. Trim the front edge and hood edge. Press the front edge as marked, then stitch.
  8. Fold the belt loop right sides together and stitch. Turn the piece right side out and press. Cut the loop into 4 pieces. Sew the belt loops to the marked lines on the front and back pieces.
  9. Fold the waistband in half lengthwise, right sides together, and stitch along three edges, leaving a 7–10 cm opening in the middle of the long edge. Turn the waistband right side out and press. Topstitch 0.5 cm from the edge, closing the opening.

Congratulations – your hoodie are finished! :)
