

If the pattern has a double line around it, the seam allowances are included.

Note: By default, seam allowances are NOT included (single line) and will need to be added when laying out and cutting details.

Seam Allowance: 1 cm on all seams; hem guidelines are printed on pattern.

Important! Please print all the paper patterns and lay them out at the width of fabric you plan to use (usually from 90 to 150 cm) to see how much fabric you will need.

Don't forget to take into account pieces to be duplicated or cut on a fold. When sewing the garment, pay attention to notches. They must match up with corresponding pieces.

7093 Short Faux Fur Hat for Children

Attention! In the construction of the pattern, **rz_48** (head circumference) is used. This measurement should be taken with a measuring tape placed horizontally around the head, passing over the middle of the forehead — where the head is the widest.

Recommendations on fabric: artificial or natural fur with a short pile, soft coat fabrics.

You will also need: lining, elastic tape.

CUTTING:

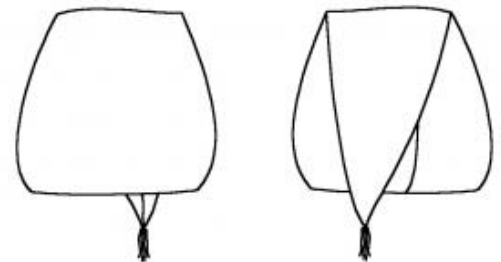
The word, “beam” used on some patterns means “straight of grain”. Some pieces will be cut on the fold, this is noted on the pattern piece. Mark all notches and other design features such as darts, pleats etc. from the pattern onto your fabric.

Seam allowances: all seams 1 cm.

Main fabric:

Crown – 1 piece

Lining fabric:



Crown – 1 piece

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Fold the crown piece with right sides together and sew using small overcasting stitches along the edge. Flatten the seam with a hammer.
2. Turn the edge of the crown to the wrong side and sew with small overcasting stitches, slightly tightening the thread and leaving an opening for inserting the elastic tape.
3. Sew and press the lining seam. Insert the lining into the crown, matching the seams of the lining and the outer fabric. Turn the lining edge inward and sew with small invisible stitches.
4. Insert the elastic tape.

Congratulations – your hat are finished! :)
