

If the pattern has a double line around it, the seam allowances are included.

Note: By default, seam allowances are NOT included (single line) and will need to be added when laying out and cutting details.

Seam Allowance: 1 cm on all seams; hem guidelines are printed on pattern.

Important! Please print all the paper patterns and lay them out at the width of fabric you plan to use (usually from 90 to 150 cm) to see how much fabric you will need.

Don't forget to take into account pieces to be duplicated or cut on a fold. When sewing the garment, pay attention to notches. They must match up with corresponding pieces.

7147 Baby hat with ear flaps

Recommendations on fabric: dense cotton fabric, fleece, woolen fabric, dense silk or whipcord.

You will also need: lining (cotton desired); cord or ribbon for ties.

CUTTING:

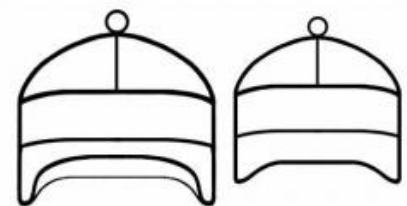
The word, "beam" used on some patterns means "straight of grain". Some pieces will be cut on the fold, this is noted on the pattern piece. Mark all notches and other design features such as darts, pleats etc. from the pattern onto your fabric.

Seam allowances: all seams – 1 cm, on bob edge – 0 cm.

Main fabric:

1. Gusset – 4 details
2. Side – 2 details
3. Ear (hall) – 2 details
4. Bob – 1 detail

Lining:



1. Gusset – 4 details
2. Side – 2 details

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Sew the gussets together, right sides facing.
2. Sew the sides together. Attach the gussets to the sides.
3. Sew the center seam of the ear pieces. Fold the ears right sides together and stitch along the outer contour, inserting the ties. Turn right side out and press. Topstitch the lower edge of the ears.
4. Sew the outer side of the ears to the side piece.
5. Assemble the lining the same way as the main fabric. Insert the lining into the hat, matching the seams of the lining and the main fabric. Turn under the free edge of the inner ear piece and topstitch along the joining seam.
6. Tie the pom-pom onto a thread, fill it with pieces of padding (sintepun), and sew it to the center of the bonnet.

Congratulations, your hat is ready! :)
